### **An Exciting Year of Adult Bible Study Ahead!**

Bible Study will be a weekly staple for adults on Wednesdays this year. We'll offer these in series that give us topical variety. Our pastor, Dr. Charles Qualls, will be the lead teacher. Here's how we'll start:

***Prayer in the Life of Jesus***  
**9 weeks (September 12-Nov. 14)**

Each week...two concepts. A Bible study around one episode of Jesus praying. Compelling stories that show Jesus connecting with God the Father. Then, each week, we'll explore one ancient technique that gives us a new practice for our prayer. Don't worry; no weird stuff!

These sessions are supported by two books: Prayer in the Life of Jesus by Dr. Paris Donehoo and Beginning Prayer by Dr. John Killinger.
