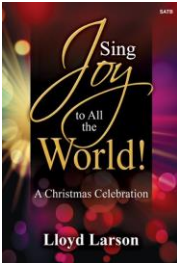
## Wednesday Night Bible Study

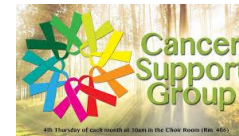
## Faith on Draft – Faith and Science October 3<sup>rd</sup> at 6:30 PM (Fred's Restaurant Upstairs)
