October Festival – October 30, 2019

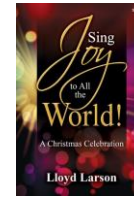
Come join us for a night of fun, games, food and fellowship on Wednesday, October 30th, from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM.
