Mark Edwards served as Minister of Music at First Baptist Church, Nashville, Tennessee for thirty years. He “retired” in October 2007 and became the Vice-President of Celebrating Grace, Inc. Mark shepherded the production of the Celebrating Grace Hymnal (released in March 2010), became the face of the project, and led the committee of composers and arrangers that produced more than 1,500 choral, orchestral, keyboard, and handbell accompaniments for congregational singing. In July 2013, Mark retired from Celebrating Grace, but remains on a retainer with them.

During his extended music ministry in Nashville, Mark was a frequent choral clinician, conference leader, adjunct college instructor, literary writer and musical arranger. Much of the focus of his music ministry has been congregational singing. His numerous published works include a textbook on congregational singing and dozens of hymn settings for congregation, choir, vocalists, piano and organ. He has served on two hymnal committees, presided over the Baptist Church Music Conference, and was awarded the Distinguished Service Award from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary’s School of Music. Mark is a south Texan, educated at Howard Payne University and Southwestern Seminary.

Mark and his wife Susie (deceased) have two children and five grandchildren (in whom they are well-pleased). Mark’s leisure time is given to woodworking, mentoring, and grandfathering.



Carol Williams, is a British born composer, concert organist and San Diego Civic Organist Emerita.

Carol could read music before English. She began her training at the Royal Academy of Music, and was awarded all the major prizes for organ. She became a Fellow of the Royal College of Organists, a Fellow of Trinity College London, and Associate of the Royal College of Music, and also studied in Paris with Daniel Roth.

Carol Williams also was a student at Yale University, studying with Professor Thomas Murray, and was awarded the Artist Diploma and the Charles Ives prize for outstanding achievement. She earned her Doctorate of Musical Arts at Manhattan School of Music and received the Helen Cohn award. Carol was the Former Chapel Organist, Yale University; Associate Organist, Cathedral of the Incarnation, Garden City, NY; Artist in Residence, St. Paul's Cathedral, San Diego; and presently serves as Artist in Residence at Court Street United Methodist Church, Lynchburg, VA.

She is the host for "TourBus" the documentary series featuring the Large & Small, Famous & Unique pipe organs of the world, and "On The Bench" YouTube series interviewing musicians.

When asked about her goal in life, she replied: "I want to bring the pipe organ to a broader audience and, with my performance, make people feel good."

The Reverend Dr. Gerald "Gerry" Robinson recently retired after serving 46 years in ministry.

He graduated from the University of Richmond with a double major in Music and Religion. He received the Master of Divinity with Church Music degree from Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary, and then the Doctor of Ministry degree from Baptist Theological Seminary in Richmond.

Gerry has served churches in Virginia and North Carolina in a variety of roles as minister of music and worship, associate pastor, and discipleship.

He was very active in the American Orff Society of America where he achieved Level 3 training, the Hymn Society of the US and Canada, Choristers Guild, and Handbell Musicians of America. In Virginia, he was a long-time member of the VA Baptist Male Chorale, and was on faculty at the VA Baptist Music Worship Arts Camp for 33 years teaching recorders, Orff, and world drumming.

Gerry is married to Betty. They have 3 sons and 6 grandchildren.

Today marks the culmination of many months of preparation and work from many people. We are delighted to have special guests with us today, whose skill and expertise lead us in the worship of God as we dedicate our hymnals. Please speak to them following worship today, and express your gratitude for their worship leadership. (Their bios are included for your information.)

The seed for a new hymnal has been active for some time. Slowly, but surely, people embraced the idea of a new hymnal, and the natural choice was the Celebrating Grace Hymnal. This hymnal contains numerous favorite hymns, as well as new hymns which one day will become favorite hymns. Even the title of the hymnal makes a theological statement – all of us are children of grace.

The hymnal is structured into two grand, sweeping themes: I Will Be Your God, and You Shall Be My People. In each section, there are subsections that further amplify and give definition to the themes. Hence, I Will Be Your God contains God the Trinity - Mystery of Three in One; God the Father - The Source of All Being; God the Son - The Incarnate One; and God the Spirit - Transforming Presence. You Shall Be My People contains God's People - The Church as Community; God's People - The Church at Worship; and God's People - The Church on Mission.

As you explore the Celebrating Grace Hymnal each Sunday, you will discover new texts to favorite tunes, so that a tune can be utilized in multiple church seasons.

We give thanks to God for the generosity of many who donated one or more hymnals in honor or in memory of loved ones. Special thanks is extended to our faithful and dedicated church staff for their work above and beyond their normal work load, to prepare and print labels, to place labels in each hymnal, and finally for their aid in the great hymnal exchange.

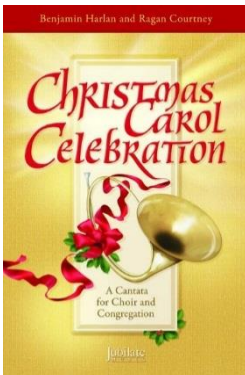
