Rural Area Medical (RAM) - Free Medical Clinic
Greensville High School
403 Harding Street, Emporia, VA 23847
 June 23-24, 2018.

Clinic will offer free, high quality vision, dental and medical services on a first-come, first-serve basis, including such things as health exams, dental care including cleanings, extractions, fillings and vision care even including eyeglasses to individuals in need of them. One can get information on women's health including mammograms, and other health education. No insurance or identification will be required. It is totally free and open to the public.

The parking lot will open no later than 12:00 AM and numbered tickets will be distributed on a first come, first served basis at 3:00 AM. The clinic doors will open at 6:00 AM each day.

Help is needed for this clinic.

- Volunteer to help set-up, take-down, or help patients receive the help they need (you don't have to be a medically trained person, they need regular folks to help with directing parking, directing patients, etc.)


